


Entourage SMTP Auth

- Open Entourage
- Click on “Tools”
- Click on “Accounts”
- Click on “Mail”
- Click on your mail account
- Click on the “Edit” button
- Under “Sending Mail” change the SMTP server to smtp.dnsmaster.net
- Click on “Click here for advanced sending options”
- Check “SMTP server require authentication”
- Select “Use same settings as receiving mail server”
- Click on the box in the upper-left corner to close the pop-up
- Click on the “Ok” button
- All Done!
